

## **Red Gakyil Report**

April 11, 2026

### **Projects recently completed**

#### **Schoolhouse**

- 1) Second of three gonpa doors with rot has been removed, replaced with wall, and painted; siding installed outside both this and the previously removed door on opposite wall. Total cost for both \$3216.03

#### **Khandroling**

- 1) Ramp to Rinpoche's cabin has been repaired; all materials and labor were donated.

### **Projects planned for this year**

#### **Schoolhouse**

- 1) Foyer bathroom rot remediation, siding repair \$1440 to be completed by June.
- 2) Second floor fire escape door replacement, framing and window replacement \$3697 to be done by June.

#### **Khandroling**

- 1) Guardian Cabin repairs: labor and materials will be donated (excluding decorative eave pieces), and completed by June. Guesstimate for eaves, if replaced rather than removed, \$1500
- 2) Farmhouse porch roof leak repair to be done by June, \$1160
- 3) Sanding and staining farmhouse porch floor and back deck \$2000 guesstimate
- 4) Sanding and sealing Vajra Hall roof beams to protect and preserve them, estimate pending.
- 5) Painting interior of Mandarava cabin, using donated labor, and materials that were previously purchased at minimal cost.
- 6) Finishing stonework at stupa entrance \$800.

### **Projects needed, depending on fundraising and community priorities**

#### **Schoolhouse**

- 1) Re-paving parking lot approximately \$40,000. Less expensive options are being explored.

- 2) Renovating dormitory to make additional much-needed private accommodations approximately \$40,000 due to likely presence of asbestos in floor.
- 3) Installing a functional handicapped ramp to the rear entrance, estimate needed.

### **Khandroling**

- 1) Installing water collection system at Vajra Hall should cost about \$2500
- 2) Completing installation of Memorial Garden up to \$15,000 depending on design and extent of plantings
- 3) Installing information signs for stupa, Vajra Hall, and commemorative sign to mark site of Rinpoche's first Vajra Dance mandala approximately \$1500
- 4) Installing Vajra Dance Historic Landmark garden at the site of Rinpoche's first Vajra Dance mandala approximately \$15,000 depending on design extent of development
