- I am in favor of a facelift for the schoolhouse lobby painting and some decorative elements. I do not think that we need a video monitor in the lobby for informational purposes
- I am in favor of a facelift for the Gonpa painting
- I am in favor of re-organizing and fixing up the dorm space if it provides more sleeping units, income, privacy for visitors
- I am not in favor of any kind of reorganization of the first floor space. I do not see any advantage to doing this. The library space works well, the bookstore and administrative spaces do as well.
- I am not in favor of reorganizing the space in the Gonpa creating partitions, separate rooms, etc.
- Other than the above, my long term interests for the schoolhouse are the following:
- I am interested in creating a handicapped restroom, but only to the extent that access to
 the first floor of the schoolhouse is handicapped accessible. I am not an expert in this
 area and this would require the involvement of the members of our community who are
 experienced contractors
- Repave the parking lot
- Assess the condition of the furnaces for both the Gonpa and the schoolhouse. We know they are not in good shape.
- Assess the condition of and need for a new roof
- Other than that, I think our infrastructure priorities should center around Khandroling cabin maintenance, road maintenance, planning to make the Vajra Hall usable in more than the fair weather months.
