NAMO GURUBHYA NAMO DEVABHYA NAMO DAKINIBHYA According to the system of Lower Tantras or to the method related to Guruyoga, the essence of the profound paths, in the space in front of us we imagine the presence of Guru Arya Tara as the essence that unifies all the objects of refuge:

OM GURU ARYATĀRA SAPĀRIVARA VAJRA SAMAYA JĀ PADMA KĀMALAYE STAM

With this mantra, together with the mudra, we invite Guru Arya Tara and ask her to remain. Then we recite the invocation:

OM JÉZUNMA PÀGMA DRÓLMA KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ

We repeat the invocation two, three, or seven times since this is the quantity prescribed in the *Twenty-One Praises to Tara*. If we like, we can add the invocations:

OM LAMA GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ
OM YIDĂM GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ
OM KÀDRÒ GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ
OM QOSGYOÑ GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ
OM NORLHA GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ
OM GYABNÁS GUNDÙS PÀGMA DRÓLMA
KYEDLA DÙDDO ZEVAS GYOÑ

At the end we properly activate Tara's wisdom with the mantra:

OM TĀRE TUTTĀRE TURE SVĀHĀ

We recite the mantra many times, for instance forty-two, sixty-three, or one hundred and forty-seven times. Then we recite the invocation:

JÉZUN PÀGMA DRÓLMA KYED KYÈNNO JÌG DĂÑ DÚGÑÀL GUNLAS GYABDU SÒL

We repeat the invocation two, three, or seven times, according to our possibilities. At the end we recite the essential mantra to activate the wisdom of Arya Tara:

TĀRE

We chant the essential mantra many times, for instance two hundred, three hundred, or seven hundred times, according to our possibilities, to properly activate her wisdom.

Then, in order to practice the Yoga of Arya Tara according to the Anuyoga system from a *terma* discovered by Adzom Drugpa Rinpoche, we communicate by sounding the essential seed-syllable:

$T\bar{A}M$

In the same moment that Guru Arya Tara dissolves into light and is absorbed into us, we instantly manifest as Green Arya Tara. Upon a moon disk at our heart is the seed syllable TĀM, green, possessing its own sound. While visualizing that five-colored lights expand from it and then reabsorb into the TĀM, we chant the quintessential mantra as many times as possible:

OM TĀRE TĀM SVĀHĀ

If we like, still concentrating on the five-colored lights that expand and then reabsorb, we can also chant this mantra as many times as possible:

OM TĀRE TUTTĀRE TURE SVĀHĀ

and also the essential mantra of White Arya Tara:

OM TĀRE TUTTĀRE TURE MAMA AYUR PUNYE JÑĀNA PUŞHŢIM KURU SVĀHĀ

After having completed the session, we dedicate merits and make aspirational prayers as usual, if we like elaborating with this invocation:

QÌMED CEYI BALLA LOÑJYOD JIÑ
Enjoying the glory of immortal life,
RIGBAI LÓ DĂÑ NÁMJYOD XESRAB DĂÑ
May intelligence, discriminating wisdom,
SÌD DAÑ XĬVAI BALJYÒR GĂÑ LAGBA
And whatever riches exist in samsara and nirvana
DĚ GUN LHUNGYIS DRŬBBAI DRAXIS XOG
Be spontaneously obtained. May all be auspicious!
